In addition to the CME portion of the meeting the day provided an opportunity for our membership, office managers and nurses to gain knowledge about the future activities of WVOS, a Medicare update directly from Palmetto GBA, an ASCO update on EHR Meaningful Use and the Economic Stimulus and, a Legislative update from COA.
